<b>Purpose</b>	Community Outreach Volunteers will support Komen Dallas County's efforts to promote breast self-awareness and to connect Dallas County residents with available breast health resources.
<b>Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Complete Volunteer 101 Training</li><li>• Represent Komen Dallas County at health fairs, corporate wellness events, and other community events</li><li>• Refer women with specific health questions to their healthcare provider. We cannot provide medical advice or make referrals to physicians.</li><li>• Return all education samples and supplies to the Komen Dallas County Affiliate office within ten days of your event</li><li>• Complete a brief evaluation following the event</li><li>• Have fun and help save lives through education and referral of breast health resources.</li></ul>
<b>Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Outgoing with effective communication skills</li><li>• Willingness to learn breast health information</li><li>• Timely and dependable</li><li>• Available to volunteer during the weekday, evenings, or weekends</li><li>• Possess reliable transportation</li><li>• Ability to carry and transport display materials, a minimum of 20 pounds.</li><li>• Positive, team-oriented attitude</li><li>• Belief in the importance of the mission of Susan G. Komen®</li></ul>
<b>Time Commitment</b>	Complete at least health fair or event per quarter, as opportunities are available.
<b>Volunteer training</b>	Training will be provided to all Komen Dallas County volunteers. These trainings will be offered periodically throughout the year.
